Her short stories have been commended in the 2013 FAWWA Hadow/Stuart Short Story Competition and the 2004 University of Canberra National Short Story Competition (tertiary section), and twice read on ABC Radio National. She has experience as an undergraduate creative writing tutor, workshop presenter and editorial assistant. Brooke has a PhD in Creative Writing from the University of Western Australia.
